National Championships

For this year's National Championships we go to a very special golf course, the **PGA National** in the Palmerstown House Estate, Johnston, near Naas, in Co Kildare.

It will take place on **Sunday, 16th August.**

The 1st tee has been reserved from 10.00 am to 1.00 pm

This golf course, completed in 2004, was designed by Christy O'Connor Jnr. It has already hosted a PGA European Tour event and the AIB Irish Senior's Open. As well as a magnificent golf course, it is set in fantastic surroundings around a beautiful old house.

What I am really saying is that you should make every effort to play there, at a price that will not be beaten, due to the financial support of one of our members.

Our competitions will follow the usual format. The **Bob Charles Trophy** being presented for the Best Gross. **The National Trophy** for the Best Nett and the **Martin Quinlan Trophy** for the Best Senior (Nett) aged 55 years and over. There will be Gross and Nett Prizes.

Entry will be on a first come **prepaid** basis only. Entries will **not** be taken over the phone. An Entry Form is part of this newsletter or can be printed down from our website, www.left-handed-golfers.com Right-handed golfers, male or female are welcome to play as guests.

Tee Times will be allotted as entries are received. Early entrants will get the tee time requested. In previous years, late times have proved popular and therefore are unlikely to be available to late entrants.
